**Competitions Terms & Conditions of Entry (“Conditions of Entry”)**

**Entry**

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The promoter is Travelex Limited ABN 36 004 179 953 of Level 12, 1 Margaret Street, Sydney NSW 2000, (02) 8585 7000 (the “Promoter”).

4. There will be one prize draw per Participating Outlet as part of this promotion (each a “Draw”).
5. This promotion will be open between 01/05/2010 and 30/06/2010 inclusive (the “Promotional Period”).
6. Entry to a Draw which relates a Participating Outlet will be open to any person who purchases a Cash Passport Card (“Eligible Entrant”) from

the relevant Participating Outlet during the Promotional Period (“Qualifying Purchase”). Entries under the age of 18 Must first seek permission from their parent or guardian.

7. Each Eligible Entrant will automatically receive one entry into the relevant Draw for the relevant Participating Outlet for each Qualifying Purchase from that Participating Outlet.
8. Employees of the Promoter and participants listed above and any of their related bodies corporate and their immediate families are not eligible to enter this competition.
9. All entries submitted become the property of the Promoter. All details will be held in accordance with Travelex Privacy Policy which can be accessed in Australia by visiting [www.travelex.com.au](http://www.travelex.com.au) or calling 1800 637 642.
10. Except where prohibited by law, the winner agrees that the Promoter may use the name, address and photograph of the winner for promotions, marketing and publicity, unless otherwise advised.
11. If a winner of any prize is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner’s parent or guardian.

## **12. Draw**

13. Each prize Draw will take place at Travelex’s offices at Level 5, 504 Pacific Highway, St Leonards NSW 2065.
14. Each Draw will take place on 01/07/10 between 9.00am and 11.00am (AEST).
15. Eligible Entries for each Draw will be drawn randomly from a sales report of all Cash Passport Sales made during the Promotional Period at the relevant Participating Outlet. The first Eligible Entry which corresponds to first random number generated by the random number generator will be the Prize winner for that Draw.
16. The Prize winner of each Draw will be notified within 7 business days of the Draw by phone and in writing within 14 days via the details provided by the Eligible Entrant. In addition a notice will be published in the Australian newspaper on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2010
17. The prize for each Draw is a Cash Passport Card loaded with an amount equivalent to AU\$1,000 (the “Prize”). There are two types of Cash Passport Cards. The Prize winner will have a choice between an ATM Only card and a POS enabled Debit card. Cards are available in a number of currencies. The Prize winner will be able to choose a

Cash Passport Card in one of the available currencies. The AU\$1,000 loaded onto the Cash Passport Card will be converted into the currency of the Cash Passport Card on the day it is loaded by Travelex Limited, at the rate at which Travelex Limited loads Cash Passport Cards on that day.

18. The total prize pool for this promotion is valued at AU\$19,000 (i.e. a prize of AU\$1,000 for each draw).
19. The Prize must be taken as stated. The prize is not exchangeable or transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash or other goods or services. If a winner is unable to use the Prize as stated it will be forfeited and no compensation will be payable.

22. The Travelex Cash Passport Card is subject to the Cash Passport Terms and Conditions. By accepting the Prize a winner agrees to be bound by the Cash Passport Terms and Conditions. Fees and charges apply to the use of the Travelex Cash Passport Card and these are set out in the Cash Passport Terms and Conditions. The complete Cash Passport cardholder terms and conditions including a full list of current fees and charges will be provided to the winner with the Prize. Any applicable exchange rates, ATM fees or charges will be deducted from the total amount of funds on the card at the time the transaction is made. The card is valid for three years but inactivity fees apply after 12 months of non-usage of the card. The total amount of the Cash Passport Card can be withdrawn at once and will incur a fee depending on the country of activity
23. Each Prize must be claimed by 5.00pm (AEDST) on the first business day which falls three months after the relevant Draw.
24. If a Prize remains unclaimed on 1/10/2010 a redraw will take place at the same place and time as the original draw and the winner will be published in the Australian newspaper. The winner will be notified by phone and mail within 7 business days of the redraw subject to state regulations.

## **25. Other conditions**

26. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter and its associated agencies or companies are not liable for any:
- a. Error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of entries; or
  - b. Loss or damage whatsoever (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or personal injury however caused including, but not limited to, by their or any of their negligence, suffered by the Entrant or any other person relating to the use or enjoyment of, or non-delivery or non-useability of, a prize.

If for any reason, the Promoter is unable to run this competition as planned, including tampering, infection by computer virus, bugs, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter that corrupt or otherwise affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter may in its sole discretion disqualify any person who tampers with the entry process, and cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion, subject however to any written directions given under applicable law.
