

Key changes to Cash Passport Terms and Conditions

We are making some changes to our UK Cash Passport Terms and Conditions.

These changes reflect the new Electronic Money Regulations 2011 ('the Regulations'), which will be implemented in the UK on 1st May 2011.

The changes alter the terms of the agreement between you and the issuer ('Agreement') which are summarised below and shall become effective from 1st May 2011.

Set out below is a summary of the key changes to the existing Terms and Conditions:

Expiry of the Card

If your Card has expired, or if you have lost or had your Card stolen, you may contact Card Services to request a replacement Card.

Cash Out Fee

You will not be charged a cashout fee, if you cash out your Card within twelve (12) months of the Agreement coming to an end.

Ending the Agreement

The Agreement will come to an end upon the later of the expiry of the Card or Additional Card (if applicable). You may end the Agreement immediately by writing to, or emailing us, and we may end the Agreement by either giving you 60 days notice, or without notice if you materially breach the Terms and Conditions.

Unless otherwise stated, all other Terms and Conditions remain unchanged.
